### PLAYGROUND



A playground featuring interactive sculpture, swings, and climbing structures with a focus on using natural elements to promote creative play. There is approximately 200m<sup>2</sup> available.

The playground would be constructed to look like existing tracks and trails elements, using timber.

Pump tracks are created using compacted soil to build a series of rollers, banked turns and small jumps. The Board would be careful to create a beginner-friendly course focusing on bike handling skills. This would provide a casual activity for children and adults.

There is approximately 400m<sup>2</sup> available for either a playground or track on this site, known as the Tennis Court Site.
