Guest Experience, Hospitality Operations & Site Management

Lead the delivery of a high-quality, memorable guest experience across all Alpine Nature Experience offerings, including:

- Welcoming and hosting guests at the Eco-Village
- Leading guided activities (snowshoe tours and selected summer experiences)
- Coordinating and delivering dinners, breakfasts, and glamping experiences
- Ensuring daily site preparation, presentation, and cleanliness to a consistently high standard
- Creating a relaxed, professional and premium atmosphere aligned with ANE's brand values
- Processing guest payments and handling on-site guest queries

Operations, Safety & On-Site Decision-Making

Oversee day-to-day operations of the Eco-Village, including:

- Making key safety, logistical, and commercial decisions during tours and experiences
- Acting as on-site decision-maker in the absence of the owner and providing clear debriefs/reporting
- Monitoring weather, guest readiness, equipment, and site conditions to adapt experiences as required
- Ensuring compliance with safety procedures, food handling standards, and RSA requirements

Manage people, infrastructure, and resources, including:

- Supervision and coordination of Eco-Village Coordinators during preparation and service delivery
- Supporting team onboarding, task allocation, and on-the-job training
- Preparing, maintaining, and packing down Tipis, Hypedomes, tents, and Eco-Village infrastructure
- Managing equipment, stock, and supplies (food, beverages, firewood, water, consumables)
- Identifying maintenance needs, minor repairs, and continuous improvement opportunities

Marketing, Communication & Brand Representation

Support the visibility and storytelling of Alpine Nature Experience by:

- Facilitating media famil trips and influencer visits on-site
- Creating social media content (Reels, stories, posts) in line with brand guidelines
- Capturing photo and video content where relevant (optional, depending on skillset)
- Contributing to guest-facing communication and experience storytelling

Contribute to the evolution and commercial strength of the business by:

- Actively participating in continuous improvement of guest experiences
- Assisting in the development and testing of new products, experiences, or events
